FTEAP Grant Award Criteria

## 1. Criteria for Grant Award

- a) The project must align with FTEAP's vision, mission, and priorities (see [www.fteap.org](http://www.fteap.org)).
- b) Theological schools/seminaries and ecumenical institutions that have received three consecutive years will not be considered. However, the school can apply after a lapse of one year.
- c) Theological schools/seminaries that have not received FTEAP grants in the past will be given priority.
- d) The utilization reports of FTEAP grants received in the previous year must be submitted along with the project proposal.
- e) The grant should be at most \$ 5000 per year for an individual or a joint innovative project of two or more theological schools/seminaries.
- f) The Regional Theological Association, Ecumenical Theological Networks, and Doctoral Consortiums may apply for grants yearly for various creative programs upon fulfilling the FTEAP grants agreement.
